thanksgiving pumpkins
for your dinner table.

Thanksgiving Pumpkins

Supplies: strips of orange paper, stapler, hole punch, felts, green pipe-cleaner, green "leaves" cut out of paper with "I am thankful for..." written on them.

Directions: Cut strips of orange paper about an inch wide. Staple three together in a star shape. Punch a hole in the end of each "arm" of the star. Write things you are thankful for on each arm. You will want to be sure not to write all the way to the end of the arm where the hole is, as that part will be covered by the leaves when you attach them together.

Take a green pipe-cleaner and twist the end into a small circle or knot that won't pull through the punched holes. Bring the arms of the star up, matching the holes. Pull the pipe-cleaner up through the center, attaching the arms together and forming your round pumpkin shape. Add your leaf on top by running the pipe-cleaner through that as well. Coil the pipe-cleaner by winding around your finger or a pencil so that the leaf will stay in place. Enjoy!
